- Gaming and Liquor Act (ie: Open liquor, public intoxication)
- Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act (ie: Littering, dumping of garbage complaints)
- Trespass to Premises Act
- Off Highway Vehicles

#### Community Peace Officers

Community Peace Officers are employed by the Municipality and have received Peace Officer Appointments from the Alberta Solicitor General's Department

This appointment allows the Peace Officers to provide law enforcement services relating to Provincial Acts and Regulations within specific territorial jurisdictions.

### Jurisdiction

Foothills Patrol Officers have the authority provide enforcement services within the M.D. of Foothills in the following areas:

- All local roads
- Three digit Provincial Highways
   (ie: # 549, # 783, # 552, #540 etc.)
- Hamlets: (De Winton, Aldersyde, Cayley, Millarville, Blackie, Priddis)

Foothills Patrol Officers can offer assistance to other emergency services agencies at collisions and other incidents throughout the municipality.

#### Commercial Vehicle Enforcement

Foothills Patrol Officers provide enforcement services relating to the movement of commercial vehicles within the municipality including the following areas:

#### **Weights and Dimensions**

- Each patrol vehicle is equipped with portable scales
- Road ban enforcement is a priority for the Patrol Officers in the spring
- Weight enforcement continues throughout the year, in all areas of the municipality.
- Issuance and monitoring of overload / overdimensional permits for commercial vehicles

#### **Commercial Vehicle Safety Inspections**

- All Foothills Patrol Officers are Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) Certified Inspectors
- Each patrol officer is required to conduct a minimum of 32 safety inspections on commercial vehicles annually

### Traffic Enforcement Services

Foothills Patrol Officers are authorized to provide traffic enforcement pursuant to the Traffic Safety Act and all associated Regulations within the municipality including, but not limited to:

- Speeding
- Stop Signs
- Careless / Erratic Driving
- Commercial Vehicles
- Passing School Buses with lights flashing
- Parking
- Equipment Violations

Requests for patrols can be made to Foothills Patrol in an effort to address problematic traffic issues on local roads and three digit Provincial Highways.

Our Officers are members of a dedicated traffic enforcement services unit who will make every effort to follow up on complaints in an effort to improve safety and reduce traffic violations / hazards within the municipality.
